## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### International C-Show (ECAHO)

Open for Purebred Arabian Horses registered in a WAHO recognized studbook by the closing date of entry. Title Show or A-Show Gold and Silver medal winners (Champions) are not allowed to take part in the show for the rest of that calendar year and the two calendar years following, unless the horse has passed from a junior to a senior category. Anybody entering an overqualified horse will be liable to a fine of 600 Euro and the horse will be disqualified.

### International Show for Shagya-, Anglo- and Partbred Arabians

Open for Shagya-, Anglo- and Partbred Arabians with a minimum of 25% of Arabian Blood registered in an ordinary studbook in their country by the closing date of entry.

### European Amateur Show

Open for Purebred Arabian Horses registered in a WAHO recognized studbook and Shagya-, Anglo- and Partbred Arabians with a minimum of 25% of Arabian Blood registered in an ordinary studbook by the closing date of entry. Further limitations to participate you find in the Rules & Regulations, European Amateur Show R&R EAS - 2019/01.

### FN Dressage & Jumping Competition with international Guests + Freestyle Costume Class

Open for Purebred Arabian Horses registered in a WAHO recognized studbook, Shagya-, Anglo- and Partbred Arabians with a minimum of 25% of Arabian Blood registered in an ordinary studbook in their country by the closing date of entry. Further limitations to participate in each class and a list of approved countries please see below.

### Junior Handler Cup

Open for children and young people aged between 11 up to incl. 16 years.

**Generally: Enclose a copy of the currently valid registration and vaccination documents to the entry form!**

## PRESENTATION OF HORSES

Handlers will be dressed neatly and will not wear clothes carrying any form of advertising, which discloses the connection of the horse they are handling. Horses of a class are shown initially together on the ring walking in hand. In the individual presentation horses are then presented at first trotting in hand on the ring and then standing and walking in front of the judges. The EAHSC show rules must be observed.

## JUDGING SHOW CLASSES

**C-Show:** Three judges will judge each class independently of each other and without catalogue, giving 1 - 10 points, where half points are possible, for the following criteria: type (breed and gender type), head and neck, body and topline, legs, movement (walk and trot).

**Show for other Arabian Breeds:** acc. C-Show with two judges.

**European Amateur Show:** Two judges will judge each class according to the Rules & Regulations of the European Amateur Show R&R EAS - 2019/01 (see separate invitation).

## JUDGING FOALS

Foals must have a minimum age of one month at the date of the show and must be shown at foot of the dam up to six month. Foals will be led by a halter. The use of metal halters and chains is forbidden. To be able to show the movements freely, foals may be turned loose in the individual presentation, while the mare is in the ring. The foals will be judged according the comparative system. The rules of EAHSC affiliated shows will apply. Foals may not qualify for any future Title or A-Show!

## CHAMPIONSHIPS

### C-Show

1. Championships will be judged as follows: The horses placed first in their class line up ordered according to age. The horses placed second in their class line up behind them in the same order. The first placed horses will be judged individually, standing and trotting. The judges will not discuss the horses. The Champion / Gold medal winner is selected from amongst the horses placed first in their class by individual written votes from each judge. The best placed horse will be Champion / Gold medal winner. In the event of a tie, the horse that received the highest number of points in its class will be declared Champion / Gold medal winner. In the event of a further tie, the "Rules for Ties in Qualifying Places" will apply.
2. The Reserve Champion / Silver medal winner will be selected in the same way as the Champion / Gold medalist from all other horses that have qualified for the Championship.
3. The Bronze medal winner (only C-Show) will be selected using the same system used to select the Reserve Champion / Silver medalist. The votes

of the judges in the Championships will be announced and will be published at the show office immediately after the judging has finished.

4. A fourth horse will be selected, which will become the Bronze medal winner should one of the three medal winners be disqualified. If this exhibit is not apparent from the voting papers, the judges will be asked to nominate one. This horse will not be announced. In the event that two or more of the medal winners are disqualified, no further substitution will be made.
5. If a horse placed first in its class is not able to take part in the Championship, the horse placed second in the class will move forward and be judged with the other horses placed first. Should a horse placed first be sent out of the ring by the judges for any reason, it will be deemed to have taken part in the championship and, therefore, the second placed horse will not be judged with the other first placed horses. Substitutions for absent first-placed or second-placed horses by third-placed or lower-ranked horses will not be permitted.
6. All horses that qualify for their respective Championships must take part in the Championship. Unless a certificate from the DC veterinarian is produced, failure to compete will disqualify the horse from the show, with its record of score and class placing being deleted and the horse being disqualified from showing for the period of one year as from the date of the show. In the event of a disqualification, horses placed behind the disqualified horse will move up a place in the class but not be entitled to enter the Championship.

The rules set down in the Blue Book 2019 of the EAHSC apply in every aspect respectively the Rules & Regulations of the European Amateur Show EAS - 2019/01. In case of doubt or differing opinions, the original English version applies. Apart from that, the following ECAHO rules apply: Rules for Conduct of Shows, Rules for Ties in Qualifying Places, Rules for Championships, Rules for Disciplinary Committees, Rules for Medication Control, IV Addendum. <http://ecaho.org/documents>

## GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The ECAHO resp. the European Amateur Show rules and regulations apply in their entirety. On submitting the entry form, all exhibitors, their agents, and associates agree to accept these regulations and to follow the organizer's instructions.
2. All exhibitors will accept the judges decisions, which are limited to this show and based on the judging system laid down in the regulations. The judges are invited by the organizer, are not paid, and are not commissioned by their breed societies.
3. All horses must be free of contagious diseases and come from a non-infected stable. They must be effectively vaccinated against equine influenza (see ECAHO Blue Book 2019 - IV. Addendum).
4. The equine passport must be presented at the show office. In case of a missing vaccination pass, or any suspicion of contagious disease, the organiser may have the horse examined by a veterinarian at the owner's costs. The organiser is entitled to have the horse quarantined according the veterinarian's decision. It is strongly advised to vaccinate against virus abort. ECAHO Rules for Medication Control (see Blue Book 2019 page 25) will apply.
5. The organiser accepts no responsibility for accidents, illnesses, theft, fire, or any kind of damage, whether to people or to animals and objects, in particular, no third party liability for any damages. The owners of all horses or other animals at the show must have legal liability. Everyone is personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by himself, his associates etc., or his horses.

6. No compensation for transportation costs will be granted.
7. Entry fee for the show classes no. 1-14 is 70 € per horse and in classes no. 15-31 and A1-A18 40 € per horse. The fee has to be paid in advance, otherwise horses might be excluded from the show. Reservations for stabling must be sent together with the entry form and will only be considered if the fee of 125 € incl. VAT (for the whole weekend including first bedding) is paid. 8. Closing date of entries is the 21st of May 2019. Late entries are possible. A fee of 20 € per horse will be charged (increased costs due to changes in the catalog or slip of paper with late entries).
9. In case of not taking part in the event, the entry fee will not be refunded.
10. For the riding classes please fill out the complete entry form. The data will be used for the show catalog.
11. The exhibitor has to enclose a copy of the currently valid registration documents and vacations to the entry form. Incomplete entries will not be processed.
